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












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


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

Welcome to Lakeland Community Theatre's 15th Anniversary production of the beloved stage musical *Disney's Beauty and the Beast*. This huge production was challenging 15 years ago, and today during these challenging times the same still holds true.

This iconic musical with music by Alan Menken, lyrics by Howard Ashman and Tim Rice, and book by Linda Woolverton, was adapted from Walt Disney Pictures' Academy Award-winning 1991 animated musical film of the same name – which in turn had been based on the classic French fairy tale by Jeanne-Marie Leprince de Beaumont.

Critics, who hailed the film as one of the year's finest musicals, immediately noted its Broadway musical potential when it was first released, encouraging Disney CEO Michael Eisner to venture on to Broadway. All eight songs from the animated film were reused in the musical, including a resurrected musical number which had been cut from the motion picture *Human Agai*n.

Beauty and the Beast premiered on Broadway on April 18, 1994, starring Susan Egan and Terrence Mann. It was a massive commercial success and well received by audiences. The show ran on Broadway for 5,461 performances for thirteen years (1994-2007), becoming Broadway's tenth longest-running production in history. The musical has grossed more than \$1.7 billion worldwide and played in thirteen countries and 115 cities.

So I invite you to sit back, relax and enjoy our *Tale as Old as Time*.
