

Welcome to our final show of Season 36: *The SpongeBob Musical*.

The musical is based on the Nickelodeon animated television series SpongeBob Square Pants, which my kids growing up loving.

The show made its world premiere in June 2016 at the Oriental Theatre in Chicago. Following a

month of previews, the musical opened on Broadway at the Palace Theatre in December 2017.

The musical opened to critical acclaim, with twelve Tony Award nominations. It tied with *Mean Girls* for the most-nominated production at the 72nd Tony Awards in 2018. The show closed at the Palace Theatre on September 16, 2018 after 29 previews and 327 regular performances. A non-Equity North American tour opened on September 22, 2019 at Proctors Theatre in Schenectady, New York but was canceled due to the Covid-19 Pandemic. On December 7, 2019, Nickelodeon aired a television special of the show featuring members from the original Broadway cast.

An interesting fact about this musical is that each song is written by a different artist, not normally the norm in musical theatre productions.

I really love this endearing family musical, about a little yellow sponge who becomes an unlikely hero. He shows us all that just when all hope seems lost, the power of perseverance and optimism really can save the world!

Mr. Reynolds served over seven years as a regional executive board member of IATSE 477. His involvement in theatre, film, and television spans over 40 years and over 500 productions. Mr. Reynolds received his B.F.A. in Theatrical Design from Florida Atlantic University and pursued graduate studies at Carnegie Mellon University. He served as Adjunct Professor/Guest Scenic Designer at Florida Southern College and Southeastern University and as Resident Designer of LCT and TWH. Mr. Reynolds' numerous directing credits include Tommy, Shrek, The Bridges of Madison County, Mary Poppins, Rock of Ages, Mel Brooks' Young Frankenstein, Sweeney Todd, Les Mis, The Addams Family, Spamalot, Aida, You Can't Take it with You, A Christmas Story, The Last Night of Ballyhoo, Chicago, Macbeth, Godspell, Always...Patsy Cline, The Producers, Of Mice and Men, The Man Who Came to Dinner. 




