Welcome to our 38 th Season and our first offering *Nunsense: The Mega - Musical Version!* The last time the sisters appeared on our stage was in 1995 in our original LCT production of *Nunsense!* and we are very happy to welcome them back!

The musical comedy's book, music, and lyrics is by Dan Goggin. Originating as a line of greeting cards, Goggin expanded the concept into a cabaret

show that ran for 38 weeks, and eventually into a full-length musical. The original Off-Broadway production opened December 12, 1985, running for 3,672 performances and becoming the second-longest-running Off-Broadway show in history (after *The Fantasticks*, which we are also producing the season).

The show has since been adapted for television and has spawned six sequels and three spin-offs. By the time it closed, it had become an international phenomenon translated into at least 26 languages with more than 8,000 productions worldwide. It has grossed over \$500 million worldwide, and more than 25,000 women have played in "Nunsense" productions worldwide.

So I hope you're ready to laugh at the show that became an international habit! (You see what I did there...LOL)

Mr. Reynolds served over seven years as a regional executive board member of IATSE 477. His involvement in theatre, film, and television spans over 40 years and over 500 productions. Mr. Reynolds received his B.F.A. in Theatrical Design from Florida Atlantic University and pursued graduate studies at Carnegie Mellon University. He served as Adjunct Professor/Guest Scenic Designer at Florida Southern College and Southeastern University and as Resident Designer of LCT and TWH. Mr. Reynolds' numerous directing credits include Tommy, Shrek, The Bridges of Madison County, Mary Poppins, Rock of Ages, Mel Brooks' Young Frankenstein, Sweeney Todd, Les Mis, The Addams Family, Spamalot, Aida, You Can't Take it with You, A Christmas Story, The Last Night of Ballyhoo, Chicago, Macbeth, Godspell, Always...Patsy Cline, The Producers, Of Mice and Men, The Man Who Came to Dinner, I Hate Hamlet, Sanders Family Christmas, Moonlight and Magnolias, Swing! and The Last

Five Years. In 2010 Mr. Reynolds received the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts American College Theatre Festival Meritorious Achievement Award for Excellence in Direction. 


